Elizabeth Noonan is vice president of Bioscience & Technology for St. Louis County Economic Council’s Business Development Division. She leads the organization’s economic development initiatives in bioscience and technology in order to grow these important sectors and increase the visibility of St. Louis County as an industry leader in the biosciences. Noonan also coordinates with industry and service providers in connection with regional efforts to support the biosciences.

Noonan’s responsibilities currently are focused on expanding the Economic Council’s support of the plant and life sciences industry. These efforts include the development of the Helix Center, a small business incubator for early stage plant and life sciences companies, as well as overseeing implementation of the Helix Fund, which provides financial support for companies in the sector and for the entrepreneurial talent needed to support their growth.

Previously, Noonan worked in the Economic Council’s Real Estate & Community Development Division where she was responsible for managing economic redevelopment projects (such as Brownfields development) within communities that have experienced disinvestment and blight.

Prior to joining the Economic Council, Noonan was in private practice with Weil, Gotshal & Manges in Washington, D.C., focusing primarily in the area of environmental law. Noonan holds a bachelor’s degree from Brown University along with a J.D. and master’s degree in social work from Washington University in St. Louis.
