Most recently, Tucker has served on the Cross Roads Neighborhood Association committee until he returned to St. Louis to accept the Economic Council position. He also served on the Mayor's Homeless Task Force, City Living Campaign, Woman's Safe House, and was a Boy Scout troop volunteer.
